Walk Summary:	<p>This walk is in the State Forest North East of Mitchell River National Park: an area rarely visited by bushwalkers. To get to the start point we will drive for approximately 90 minutes from Lindenow through quite picturesque forests with opportunities for wildlife spotting. The walk starts at the Merrijig Track and follows an old overgrown forestry track through mostly open forest with a range of wildflowers just coming into bloom. The final section of the walk is quite steep and all off track with plenty of bush bashing, rock hopping and clambering over fallen trees. A reasonable level of fitness is required and good quality footwear is a must. At the summit we will lunch under a full canopy of mature trees before retracing our steps back to Merrijig Track.
