The Huts walk was officially opened in Ap 2011, it links Mt Hotham significant historic huts. We start this walk at the Loch Reservoir and gradually climbs up towards Mt Loch. We detour off the track to head to the top of Mt Loch where there are some unique views of historic landscapes at the top to make the effort worth We then head to Derrick hut and then onto Spargo's hut. Along the Golden Point Spur then down to a bridge that crosses a peaceful bubbling creek for lunch. We zig zag up a steep unforgiving hill until we come to the Cobungra Ditch Track.
