Walk Summary:	Please Note: This walk is dependent upon the re-opening of the Croajingolong NP by Parks Vic after the 2019/20 bushfires that ravaged East Gippsland. With PV unable to confirm a timeline for the re-opening we may have to re-schedule – so stay tuned! In the event we can go the plan is to car camp at Mueller River and explore the vast dune field, visit the Point Hicks Light Station, take in coastal forests (now burnt) and explore estuaries and sweeping beaches. Wind through coastal banksias and heathland before opening out into a network of sandy trails and explore a unique landscape of soaring sand dunes towering 30m above the Thurra River. Experience pristine natural beauty and immerse yourself in history walking to the Point Hicks Light Station, and explore other heathland and beach tracks, rock pools and view shipwrecks. Due to the severe fire damage the landscape will undoubtedly take on a surreal appearance.
