<b>Walk Summary:</b>	<p>The Holey Plains State Park is located between Rosedale and Sale south of the Princes Highway and has a number of walking tracks. We will undertake 3 walks of relatively short duration: Harrier Swamp, Banksia Forest and Long Swamp. After lunch at Holey Hill we will drive to Clearwater Lake. There will be the opportunity to see a wide variety of native plants and if we're lucky, some of the wallabies, emus and echidnas which inhabit the Park.
