Walk Summary:	This is an adventurous walk in the Mount Alfred State Forest, North East of Mitchell River National Park: an area rarely visited by bushwalkers. The walk starts at the Merrijig Track and follows the route of an old forestry track through mostly open forest with a range of understorey plants and plenty of birdlife. It is all off-track with plenty of bush bashing, rock hopping and clambering over fallen trees. There are sections of the walk which are quite steep and rocky. A reasonable level of fitness is required and good quality footwear is a must. We will climb to the summit of the Sisters North Peak and then follow a ridgeline across a saddle to a rocky bluff with panoramic views to the West, North and East.  To get to the start point we will drive for approximately 90 minutes from Lindenow (on mostly unsealed roads) through quite picturesque forests with opportunities for wildlife spotting.
