Walk Summary:	<p>This walk is through semi open forest and old vehicle tracks.</p> <p>After sorting out vehicles, we will follow a ridgeline for several km's where we reach a lookout point where there are views of the Mitchell River and the Glenaladale Weir. We then follow a four wheel drive track before entering private property where we will visit two stone relics of the past, a large stone chimney and a stone building partly built into the hillside. From here we will re enter the park and call into the Honey House on the way back to the vehicles.</p> <p>There will be the opportunity to do another walk if people are willing and time permits. We will walk down to the Glenaladale weir wall following the track that was built in the 1800's for the construction of the weir. This is the opposite side to that usually visited. About 3km return.</p>
