The walk is partly on well-made forestry tracks and partly off-track through a mix of open forest and thick regrowth scrub with some clambering over fallen logs and some rock hopping around the "head of the falls". Roaring Mag Falls is situated to the east of the Mitchell River and is in a location that provides spectacular views across the river valley to the escarpment beyond. The natural beauty of this location is guaranteed; however water coming over the falls is entirely dependent on heavy rains during the weeks preceding the walk.
