Walk Summary:	After driving aproximately 30 minutes east from Ensay, we will reach the Logie Track. After walking for about an hour, we will enter private property belonging to a local artist, and continue on this remote and picturesque bush track, through gullies and tree ferns - a haven for lyrebirds. Returning to Ensay, there may be an opportunity to visit the artist's gallery. That afternoon we will drive to the Swifts Creek camping ground on the banks of the Tambo river for a swim before walking to the pub for dinner.				
	Sunday will start at 9 am with a drive from Swifts Creek camp ground to the Cassilis gold mir area west of Swifts Creek to walk a short section of the Jirnkee water race, built in 1899 - 19 to supply various gold mining operations. This involves a steep ascent and descent, but on a clear track. After this we will explore the King Cassilis mine and treatment works, before returning home.
