<b>Walk Summary:</b>	<p>This event is limited to 25 people. It is a combined activity with SBWC. Julie Parker, a member of the Latrobe Valley Field Naturalists and SBWC, will guide the group on a ramble to observe and examine various fungi found in the forest.</p> <p>The track follows the Little Morwell River for 1km through green gullies of Eucalypts and tree ferns and then reaches a more open area on the edge of the forest. There should be numerous opportunities to look at a wide variety of fungi along the route.</p> <p>Participants should bring a small mirror, any reference books or charts , their cameras as well as lunch. Participants may wish to visit Mirboo North after the ramble (Grand Ridge Brewery; cafes) or have a stroll along the Grand Ridge Rail Trail.</p>
